

**RICHLAND COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
JULY 20, 2021**

The Richland County Board of Commissioners met on July 20, 2021 at the Richland County Courthouse with Commissioners Sid Berg, Nathan Berseth, Tim Campbell, Rollie Ehlert and Perry Miller. Others present were Administration Personnel Fossum and DeVal; State's Attorney Kummer, and Daily News Reporter Tris Anderson. Visitor Rich Slagle of Moore Engineering attended a portion of the meeting.

A motion was made by Miller and seconded by Berg to approve the Agenda as amended. Vote was unanimous.

KAYLA CARLSON - COVID UPDATE

- there is currently one active Covid case in Richland County
- the Delta Variant is increasing rapidly in the State
- 58.6% of those over 18 have received their first dose
- 56.7% are up to date on vaccination
- working on a Community Needs Assessment for Health Department Services

A motion was made by Berseth and seconded by Ehlerf to approve a Temporary Liquor License for the Black Pelican for an event at the Rodeo Grounds in Abercrombie July 24. Vote was unanimous.

Berseth reported he received a complaint regarding a Wedding Dance in Colfax Twsp where liquor was being sold without a liquor license. State's Attorney Kummer commented that law enforcement could investigate the complaint.

Fossum reported the Assn of Counties Hall of Honor for a retired employee will be awarded to a retired Richland County Employee. Two letters will need to be submitted to the Association by the County - former Administrator Bailey will write one letter and Commissioner Miller will write the second letter.

Fossum reported that a Silent Auction was held at the Auditor's Convention, half the proceeds from that auction will be donated to Richland County resident Damon Hage.

Fossum reported that two Scholarships for a Leadership Program were awarded at the Auditors Convention and Fossum was selected. She will begin the Leadership Program in September.

Berseth reported on the 5-County meeting - items discussed at the meeting included: Bonding/Banking Information, Jail, and State Radio.

Miller reported that surge spraying typically begins in August; he will follow-up with Weed Board Members Dan Thompson and Steve Ginsbach about contracting it out.

Berg reported that he and Berseth took a tour in Helendale Twsp after receiving complaints; they toured Co Rd 4, Co Rd 2 and Co Rd 23.
