MISC/CORRESPONDENCE

A motion was made by Thompson to <u>approve Temporary Liquor Licenses for the Black Pelican for Events at the Bagg Farm September 1 and September 22;</u> motion seconded by Campbell. Berseth was absent from the Vote, the remainder voted Yes and the motion carried.
