



ND Tip Program

Through a partnership with the North Dakota Sheriff's and Deputies Association, and funded by the North Dakota Department of Human Services, the Richland County Sheriff's Office is now participating in tip411 service to allow citizens to submit anonymous tips.

When you submit a tip through any of the options listed below, it is sent to a third party tip service, which acts as a privacy buffer between you and our agency in order to protect your identity and your contact information.

This service is being provided to the public for non-emergency use. Tips may not be responded to immediately. **It is not meant to be used as a substitute for calling 911 in emergency situations. In the event of an emergency, you should always dial 911.** In a non-emergency situation, but still requires an officer to respond soon, then you may dial dispatch at 701-642-7777.

There are 4 ways you can submit an anonymous tip to the Richland County Sheriff's Office.

Option 1: **MOBILE APP**

Click the icons below to download the NDTip tip411 app to your phone. To submit a tip using the app, click the "Submit a Tip" button and then select our agency.



OPTION 2: **TEXT**

To send an anonymous tip via text message to the Richland County Sheriff's Office, text the keyword **NDRICHLAND** and your tip to **847411**.

OPTION 3: **FACEBOOK**

Use Facebook to send your anonymous tip. Go to the Tip411 tab on Richland County Sheriff's Office page.

OPTION 4: **ONLINE**

Use the form below to submit your anonymous tip. Be sure to save/record your tip ID. You can use the ID to login to view feedback about your tip from the Sheriff's Office. Just enter the ID on the [tip411](#) and any feedback about your tip from the group will display. You can then submit additional information to the group.
