

The Richland County Jail has a PREA Coordinator and a PREA Investigator and continue to lead our efforts to be compliant with PREA standards.

The Richland County Jail has a PREA Audit independent auditor, auditing our facility to maintain compliance with Department of Justice standards.

It is our policy to thoroughly investigate all reports of sexual abuse or sexual harassment. If an allegation of harassment or sexual abuse is reported our department will independently work with a trained administrative investigator. If the allegation is determined to be criminal, we will coordinate with ND BCI to investigate the allegation.

All staff have been trained in PREA and continue yearly education and training on PREA.

Inmates that come through our facility are educated in how to report a possible PREA violation.
