The Richland County Jail has a PREA Coordinator and a PREA Investigator and continues to lead our efforts to be compliant with PREA standards.

The Richland County Jail has a PREA Audit independent inspector, inspecting our facility to maintain compliance with Department of Justice standards.

It is our policy to thoroughly investigate all reports of sexual abuse or harassment. If an allegation of harassment or sexual abuse is reported our department will coordinate with ND BCI to investigate the allegation.

All staff have been trained in PREA and continue yearly education and training in PREA.

Inmates that come through our facility are educated in how to report a possible PREA violation.

In 2025 there were no reports of PREA violations or allegations of sexual abuse or harassment by inmates that came through our facility.

If you or someone you know have experienced sexual assault or harassment in our facility, please report. You can contact our PREA Coordinator Sgt. Roxanne Mitchell at the Richland County Jail. You may remain anonymous if you wish.

Richland County Jail has a zero-tolerance policy for any sexual harassment or assault allegation, and each complaint will be thoroughly investigated and reviewed.
